


1. Overview of Boomplastic worktops

The worktops are made of 100% recycled plastic waste of varying origin, supplied by certified processors. As the material comes from a variety of sources, each pattern is subject to a certain colour tolerance. The boards are made of a single type of plastic, making them easily recyclable.

Characteristic features of the material:

- colour variations are possible,
- susceptible to scratching,
- resistant to chemically inert liquids,
- permanent exposure to strong UV light is not recommended,
- exposure to temperatures exceeding 90 degrees Celsius is not recommended,
- thermal expansion can be 2mm per metre in case of temperature changes of 10 degrees Celsius,
- voids can be present on the surface and the sides of the worktop.



3. General care information:

Clean the plastic worktops with a damp cloth.

Do not use abrasive cleaning agents, sponges or other cleaning products that could damage the surface.

Plastic elements are soft and therefore susceptible to scratching and discolouration caused by UV radiation and high temperature (above 90 degrees Celsius). It is recommended to use pads to protect the surface from damage.

Keep the furniture at least 2 metres away from active heat sources.

Heavy objects placed on the worktop may cause surface deformation.

Failure to follow the above guidance will void the warranty.
